Bernard D. Kuhn, 90, of rural Mentone, Indiana went home to be with his Lord and Savior and his beautiful wife at 3:35 pm, Friday, Oct. 22, 2021 at the Seasons Care Home of Warsaw, Indiana.

Bernard was born on May 26, 1931 in Fulton County, Indiana to the late Willard and Mabel (Hoffman) Kuhn. He married on May 18, 1951 at the Beaver Dam United Methodist Church of Akron, Indiana to Pauline B. "Polly" Whittenberger, who preceded him in death on Jan. 7, 2015.

Bernard was a 1949 graduate of Beaver Dam High School. He served his country proudly in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He had been a farmer all of his life as well as working for the Kosciusko County Highway Department and Sun Metal of Warsaw.

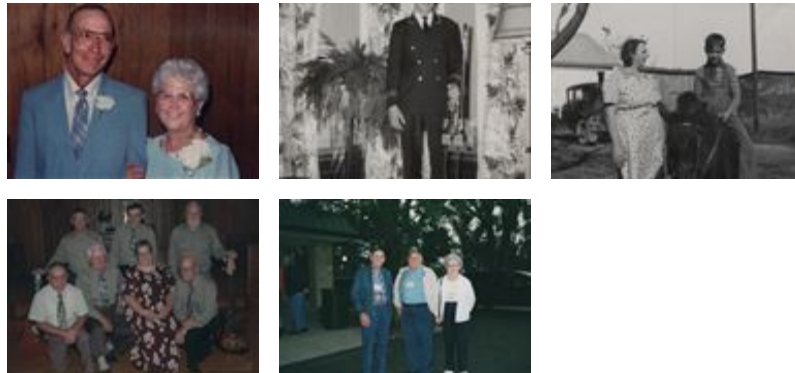
