Beverly M. Shriver, 87, of Akron, Indiana passed peacefully at 5:34 am, Tuesday, April 16, 2024 at Hickory Creek of Rochester, Indiana.

Bev was born on July 23, 1936 in Macy, Indiana to John Calvin and Onolee Ruth (Smith) Rhoades. She was a 1954 graduate of Akron High School. Following her graduation, Akron was her home the past 50 years. She had attended Olive Bethel Church of God and since 1973 the Akron Church of God.

She operated the Senior Nutrition Site in Akron for over 22 years. She also worked for the Truck Plaza Truck Stop in Rochester for 15 years and managed for the last five as well as assisted Charles and Paulene Swick in their home. Bev sold Tupperware for many years earning high sales awards, and baked cakes for area residents.
