Branigan Lee Bahney, 19, Akron, formerly of Warsaw, passed away on the afternoon of Saturday, May 2, 2015, in an automobile accident in Fulton County.

Branigan was born Oct. 14, 1995, in Peru, to Fernando Paredes and A'shel (Bahney) Santana.

He was employed at Pike Lumber Co., Akron.

In 2014, Branigan graduated from Tippecanoe Valley High School, where he played football and participated in the drama club. He was a member of the Indiana Army National Guard, Unit 113 engineers. He was also a member of the Mentone United Methodist Church where he played the bass guitar and was a youth leader.

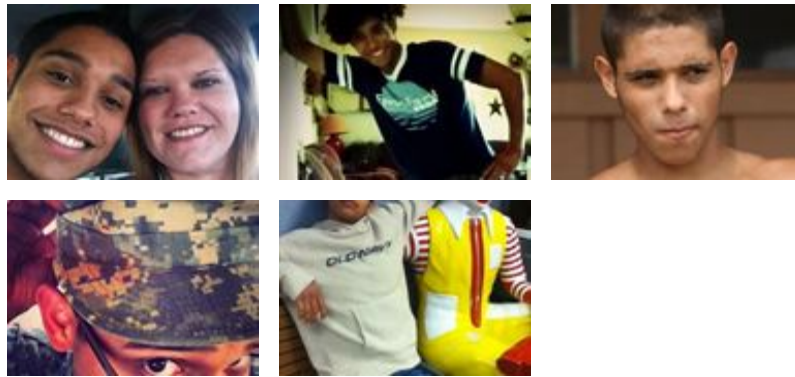
“ Branigan,
