Chad Lee Bibler, 54, of Grove City, Ohio passed unexpectedly on Sunday, July 31, 2022 at Grady Memorial Hospital of Delaware, Ohio.

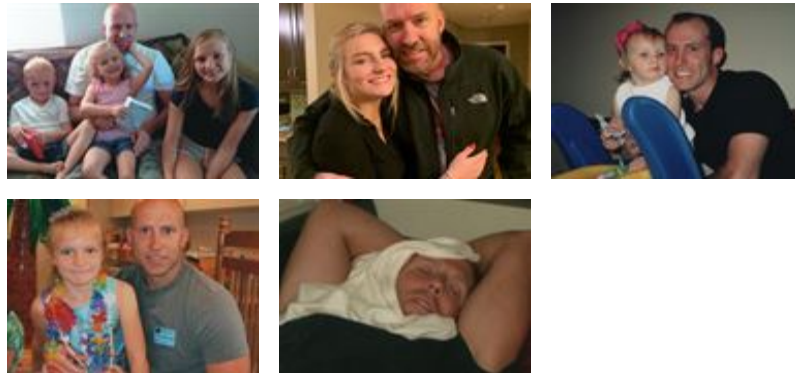

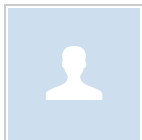

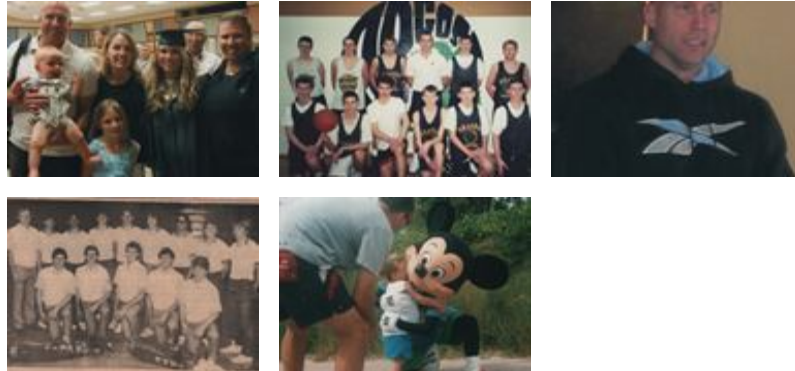
