Coleton Ryan Cahill, 18, of Silver Lake, Indiana passed from the result of an automobile accident on Sunday, July 27, 2025 near Disko, Indiana.

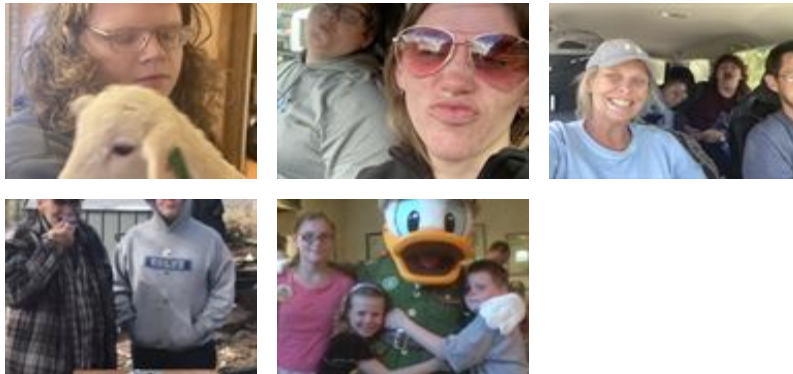

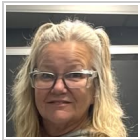
