Floyd A. Cox, 82, of rural Akron, Indiana passed at 7:42 pm, Friday, Nov. 20, 2020 at his residence.

Floyd was born on Feb. 16, 1938 in Fulton County to the late Paul and Aletha May (Clinker) Cox. He married on Nov. 27, 1957 in Plymouth, Ind. to Martha M. Ooley, who preceded him in death on March 27, 2020.

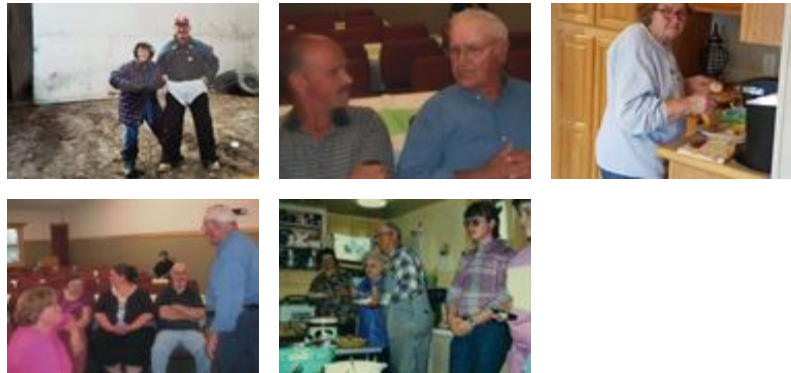
