Lori A. Miller, 60, of Mentone, Indiana passed from this life and into her eternal home unexpectedly while vacationing at 3:45 am, Monday, April 4, 2022 at the University of Tennessee Medical Center of Knoxville, Tennessee.

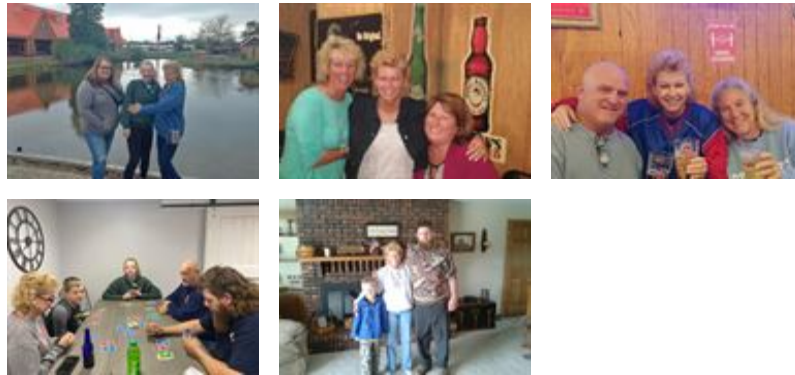
