Marian Lucille Griggs, 69, of Mentone, formerly of Bourbon, Indiana, passed away on March 11, 2025, at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne. After a lifetime of trusting Jesus, Marian had peacefully shared with her children near the end, "I'm ready to meet my Lord."

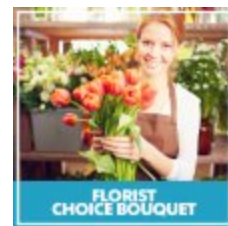
