Marilyn R. Adams, 80, of Akron, passed away at 5:25 a.m. Wednesday, July 29, 2015, at the Memorial Hospital of South Bend.

She was born on Nov. 21, 1934, in Milford, to Fred D. and Doris M. (Jennings) Haney. On Oct. 29, 1955, she was married to Raymond Adams at her parents home in Akron, and he survives.

Marilyn was a 1952 graduate of Beaver Dam High School. She then graduated from Ball State University after completing the university's 3-year program. In addition, she received a bachelor's degree from Grace College and a bachelor's degree from Purdue University.

Marilyn retired from Woodlawn Hospital after 30 years of being a registered nurse. She had also been the director of nurses.

She was a member of the Beaver Dam United Methodist Church and attended church there for 70 years. She enjoyed painting, traveling and watching the Cubs with her husband. She was known for being a community-minded person.
