Mary Nadine Ripley, 80, of Wabash, Ind. and formerly of Mustang, Oklahoma and Indianapolis passed at 5:37 pm, Saturday, Oct. 21, 2023 at Autumn Ridge Rehabilitation Centre of Wabash.
