Max L. Flenar, 75, of Etna Green, Indiana passed at 12:33 pm, Sunday, June 24, 2018 at Peabody Retirement Community of North Manchester, Indiana.

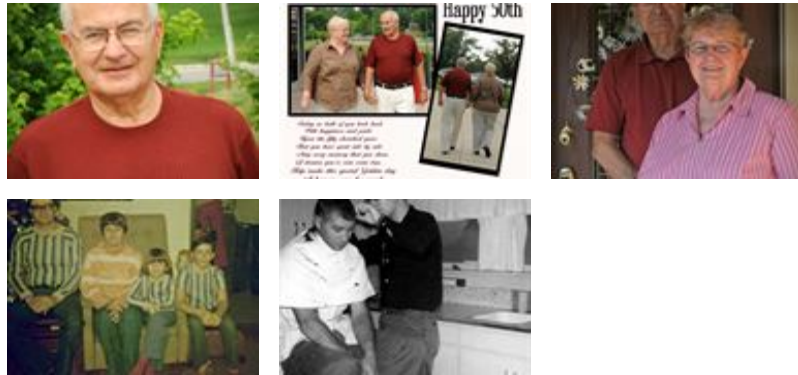
