Nancy C. Harrell, 83, Claypool, formerly of Star City, died at 3:25 a.m. Sunday, July 21, 2013, at Kosciusko Community Hospital, Warsaw, following a brief illness.

Nancy was born Oct. 13, 1929, in Star City, to parents William and Laura (Billings) Huff.

She married Lloyd W. Harrell on Dec. 24, 1950, in Star City. He preceded her in death Aug. 15, 1994.

Nancy was the office manager for Midwest Poultry Services, of Mentone, for over 20 years. In the earlier years, she worked in the Fulton County Courthouse.

She was a graduate of Star City High School. She enjoyed reading, spending time traveling to see her family and cooking.
