Nancy Ellen Trump, 76, of rural Mentone, Indiana passed surrounded by her family at 10:42 am, Wednesday, August 14, 2019 at Lutheran Hospital of Ft. Wayne, Indiana after an extended illness.

She was born on Dec. 25, 1942 in Warsaw, Ind. to James “Ted” Russell and Frances (Martin) Koch.

She married on April 2, 1967 in the Bethlehem Baptist Church of Athens to Robert S. Trump, he survives.

She worked for Ristance of Mentone and also for Niff-Corr in the office retiring in 2007 as well as being a homemaker and a mother.

She was a 1961 graduate of Talma High School. She furthered her education in 1993 by attaining her Associates Degree in Accounting from Ivy Tech Community College of Warsaw. She was a member of the Master Gardener’s and the Homemakers Extension both of Kosciusko County. She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Mentone for over 40 years and served there as an Awana leader for many years.
