



## Newt Green, III

February 2, 1949 - June 13, 2016

Newt Green III, 67, of Mentone, Indiana passed unexpectedly on June 13, 2016 at his residence.

He was born on Feb. 2, 1949 in Charleston, West Virginia to Newt and Alice Mae (Mullins) Green.

In earlier years Newt worked as a dispatcher for the Warsaw Police Dept. and in Georgia he was a gunsmith and worked in the Sheriff's Dept. in Atlanta where he repaired and cleaned guns. More recently people knew him as a wheeler dealer around the Mentone area.

Newt served his country in the United States Marine Corp. in Vietnam as a sharp shooter and received a Purple Heart Medal as well as other medals. He rode with the Jester Riding Club of Peru, Indiana for charities for children and other benefit rides and always collected tabs for Riley's Children Hospital. He had a giving heart and wanted to help others.
