Paul D. Weirick, 83, of rural Silver Lake, Indiana passed at 10:22 pm, Sunday, Feb. 5, 2017 at Kosciusko Community Hospital of Warsaw, Indiana.

He was born on Feb. 27, 1933 in Silver Lake, Indiana to Clifford and Mildred (Miller) Weirick.

He married on Jan 24, 1958 in Burket, Indiana to Mary D. Keplinger, she survives.

Paul was a farmer as well as driving for Indiana Motor Bus as a Charter Bus Driver, for LRC Company of Pierceton, and for D R Smith Trucking of Akron.
