Randy Douglas Haist, 70, of Rochester, Indiana and formerly of Brookville, Ohio passed at 2:41 am, Thursday, June 23, 2022 at Woodlawn Hospital of Rochester, Indiana.

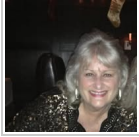
