January 1, 1935 - June 3, 2024

Raymond Adams, 89, of Akron, a beloved figure known for his sharp wit and generous spirit, passed away peacefully on the morning of June 3, 2024, at the Mason Health and Rehabilitation Center in Warsaw, Indiana.

Born on Jan. 1, 1935 in Akron, Raymond was the son of Jackson and Pauline (Personette) Adams. His early life saw him graduate from Beaver Dam High School in the class of '53. Love found Raymond when he married Marilyn R. Haney on October 29, 1955, in a ceremony at her family's home near Akron. Their union was one of love and partnership until Marilyn's passing in 2015. He mourned her passing every day.

Raymond was preceded in death by his parents, beloved wife Marilyn, brother Jack Adams Jr., and a sister Bonnie Summe.

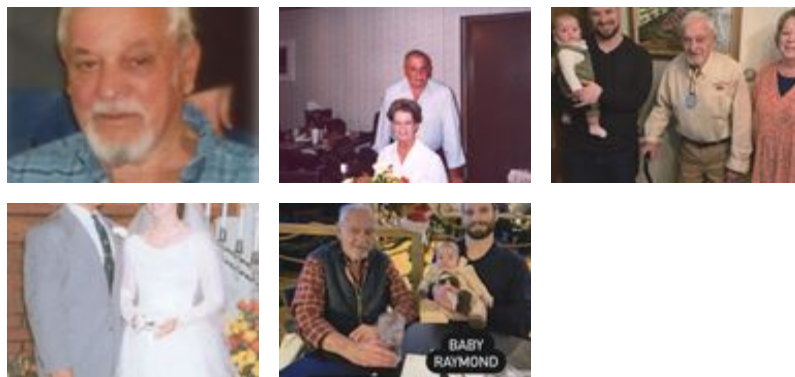
