Richard C. Webb, 86, of Mentone, Indiana passed at 1:15 am, Saturday, June 26, 2021 at Paddock Springs of Warsaw, Indiana.

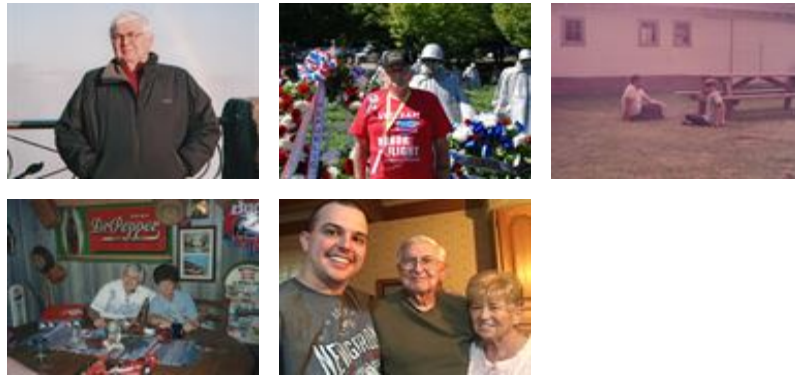
