Robert “Bob” J. Janick, 83, of rural Silver Lake and formerly of Justice, Illinois passed at 9:15 am, Saturday, June 5, 2021 at his residence.

Bob was born on April 12, 1938 in Chicago, Illinois to the late Joseph and Margaret (Petek) Janick. He was married April 28, 1962 in Chicago, Illinois to Joan Strepek, she survives.

He was a graduate of Kelly High School of Chicago, Illinois in 1956. He retired as the Superintendent for the Chicago Sun Times after 30 years with the paper. Bob was a lifetime motorcycle enthusiast.
