

Rosalie Sue Lowe

April 28, 1940 - January 29, 2021

Rosalie Sue Lowe, 80, of rural Rochester, Indiana passed away at 3:30 pm, Friday, Jan. 29, 2021 at Dupont Hospital of Fort Wayne, Indiana after being hospitalized since Jan. 13, 2021 due to Covid-19.

Rosalie was born on April 28, 1940 in Plymouth, Indiana to the late Virgil P. and Arlene R. (Lawrence) Greer. She married on July 8, 1962 in Inwood, Indiana to Richard H. Lowe, who preceded her in death on Nov. 4, 1994.

Besides being a proud breast cancer survivor she was very busy being a homemaker and working outside of her home. She worked for Model Pharmacy in Plymouth where she ran the soda fountain. She also worked for the Telephone Company of Plymouth, Farm Bureau Insurance of Plymouth, Manwarings of Mentone, Topps in Rochester, and Memorial Hospital of Logansport as switchboard operator.

She was a 1958 graduate of Plymouth High School. Rosalie had taught Sunday School at the Akron Church of God for many years. She also was a Farm Bureau member for most of her life as well as the Busy Belles Home Extension Club. She enjoyed shopping and spending time with friends. She was especially fond of bus trips and traveling with her friends and going to plays and musicals and visiting family.

She is survived by her daughter Julie A. and husband Toby Norris of Rochester, Ind., granddaughter Rebekah Lowe of Warsaw, Ind., daughter-in-law Rosemary Lowe of Rochester, sister Jeanie and George Rudich of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, brother Larry Greer of Plymouth, Ind., niece Carrie and husband Derek Schaffer of Oshkosh, Wisconsin, nephew Nick and wife Alli Rudich of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, 2 great nieces and great nephews, Wisconsin and her pug Deedee and granddog pug Haddie.

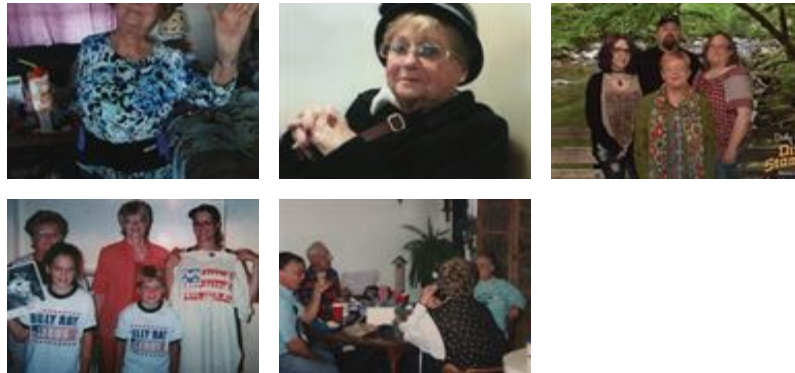
