Sue A. Greene, 76, Roann, passed away 7:45 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 16, 2014, at her residence after fighting leukemia for more than two and one-half years.

Born on Dec. 11, 1937, in Kokomo, Sue was the daughter of Paul and Katherine (Martin) Butcher.

On July 3, 1955, she married Harley D. Greene in Kokomo. This is the same year that she graduated from Kokomo High School. She worked at the Shopping Guide News for more than 30 years before retiring. She attended the Olive Branch Church of God and she loved and enjoyed spending time with her family and friends.

Survivors include her husband, Harley Greene; a daughter, Anita Greene; and a son, David Greene, all of Roann; two grandsons, D.J. Greene and Daniel Davidson, and a granddaughter, Jessika Greene; and a great-granddaughter, Khloe Harris.
