December 9, 1937 - September 20, 2024

Violet M. “Vi” Gagnon, 86, formerly of Akron, Indiana passed at 11:38 pm, Friday, Sept. 20, 2024 at Timbercrest Senior Living Community of North Manchester.

Vi was born on Dec. 9, 1937 in Wabash County, Indiana to the late Willard and Candace (Baker) Sitts. She married on June 26, 1954 in Akron to Marvin P. Gagnon, who preceded her in death on Oct. 27, 2007.

She was a dedicated homemaker and co-owner of the former Gagnon Chevrolet in Akron, where she also served as the secretary. Earlier in her career, she worked at Harris Drugs and owned a children’s clothing store in Akron. She was a long-time attendee of the Akron Church of God and an active member of the Akron Chamber of Commerce.
